

Substance Abuse Policy
Willamette Valley Water Polo Club (WVWPC)

Purpose

The WVWPC has a responsibility to its athletes, parents, coaches and the community to provide a safe and enjoyable atmosphere for the teaching and playing of water polo, and related team activities.

Drug and Alcohol Awareness Education

The WVWPC will provide drug and alcohol awareness information for its participants during the course of each water polo year (January to August). The board of directors shall review the information available to club member on an annual basis.

WVWPC position on substance abuse

WVWPC will not tolerate the consumption or possession of alcohol, drug paraphernalia, illegal substances, or use of tobacco products. An illegal substance shall also include prescription being used or taken in a manner inconsistent with the medication's labeling.

Confidentiality

The WVWPC will use every effort consistent with the circumstances to keep drug and alcohol disciplinary procedures confidential.

Signing of the Substance Abuse Policy is required each season in order to participate in club activities.
