Oregon Elite Polo and Junior Olympics program details:

- All athletes MUST be current registered athletes with an affiliated OEP program to attend camp / tryouts.
- All athletes must have a current USAWP membership and upgrade to Gold if selected for a team.
- Cost per camp / tryout is \$25.00 and must be paid prior to attending tryout.
- Athletes should be prepared to train with the team they are selected for through the end of July.
- Athletes will be required to play in the USAWP JO Qualification Tournament.
Boys JOQ May 11-13, 2018 at Mt. Hood CC. Girls JOQ June 22-24, 2018 at Curtis High School, WA.
- Athletes will be required to travel and compete in the USAWP JO tournament - San Jose, CA
Boys JO July 21-24, 2018. Girls JO July 26-29, 2018 plus travel days
- Athletes selected for teams will be required to pay a nonrefundable deposit of \$400.00 within one month of selection to a team.
